



IACUC Policy 100 : Animal Welfare Concern Policy

1. Procedure for Reporting Animal Welfare Concern, Misuse, Mistreatment, or Non-Compliance of the Care and Use of Animals in Research, Teaching and Testing
 - A. The University is committed to the ethical care and use of animals in research, teaching, and testing. If anyone is aware of potential violations to existing animal care and use regulations or observes misuse or mistreatment of animals, they are strongly encouraged to report their concerns.
 - B. Members of the university community are encouraged to report their concerns through normal lines of communication.
 - C. They and individuals from the public at large can report their concerns anonymously to the Chair of the IACUC (02-5644440 ext. 1012) or Attending Veterinarian (02-5644440 ext. 7560) or through the IACUC TU website at <http://www.lac.tu.ac.th/iacuc>
 - D. This is in accordance with Thammasat University Policy “The Complaints about the care and use of animals for scientific purposes”
 - E. The university will not have harassment of Employees or students who report actual or possible violations. They can voluntarily provide their identity and contact. The university will protect the positions person who reports actual or possible. Investigations will be conducted carefully and discreetly, with all reasonable precautions, consistent with the need for a complete and comprehensive review of the case, to maintain confidentiality to the extent permissible under law, and to protect the rights and legitimate interests of both the person making the disclosure of violation and the subject(s) of the investigation.
